Up to \$10,000 for students who are pursuing a career in legal management (JD and LLM programs excluded)	Provides national and chapter membership fees for up to 8 students annually
Requirements include: Students must be Juniors and Seniors enrolled in an accredited college/university curriculum, or currently pursuing a master's degree, with an interest in an administrative career in the legal industry	Requirements Include: Students must be enrolled in an accredited two year or four-year college/university or be actively pursuing a master's degree.
Have a cumulative GPA of 3.5	Students will complete an application and write a brief 100-200 word essay on what career in the legal industry you are trying to achieve.
Complete an application with essay, demonstration of leadership skills and community service, along with an official transcript and two letters of recommendation	Deadline: TBD
